

Program Requirements and Information

This program is intended to recognize Florida west coast area law enforcement officers and contract and proprietary security personnel, including non-management supervisors, for the award categories listed above. Security nominees must be employed in an hourly or hourly-supervisory security position. Security licenses must be in good standing.

The nominees need **not** be employed by the nominator or an ASIS member, and the nominator does **not** need to be a member of ASIS.

A committee comprised of Florida West Coast ASIS representatives will consider each application and will award recognition based upon a predetermined criteria. The committee may investigate any nomination or applicant for purposes of clarification of facts and/or verification of qualification to receive ASIS recognition. Investigations may involve interviewing the nominee, or observing him or her during the disposition of his or her duties.

Because the terms utilized in the award criteria descriptions are broad and vague, the committee will have discretionary power to determine the conditions that qualify or do not qualify for the awards. The committee may consult the ASIS leadership team and general membership. However, the committee will be the deciding body.

Nominees will not be disqualified or receive favor based upon race, gender, religion, or any other physical, cultural, or lifestyle criteria. Awards will be made upon merit, but ***not all nominees will receive an award.***
