- The scholarship will include one CPP Certification Voucher good until April 1, 2019. The Certification Voucher enables the recipient to go online at no cost and apply for the certification exam. If approved, registrants will have two years to take the certification test. The Foundation Certification Voucher does not guarantee that the recipient is eligible to take the test. Test applicants must apply, be qualified, and if deemed eligible, sit for the exam. - Applicants must be committed to obtaining the CPP certification.
